Bible Discussion: Finding Home 6

Text: 1 Peter 3:1-7

Purpose: To live out biblical submission in the home for the purpose of glorifying God and strengthening relationships.

Opening Question: What are some characteristics you appreciate about your parents' marriage?

Many of the Christians during this time of 1 Peter have lost their jobs, faced persecution and have been rejected by their family because of their faith. Peter's main hope is that we are living not for this world but for the next. Part of living toward our next home is to walk in this life with a healthy submission to authority. To strengthen an already weak view of marriage Peter teaches the distinct roles for husbands and wives and how they cooperate with each other to benefit each person in a marriage.

Read and Discuss: 1 Peter 3:6b-7

 - b. Women. What are some of the inner qualities you value in yourself?
