Read and Discuss: Judges 14

- 2. How can our own selfish desires lead to trouble? How can we protect ourselves from our own desires when they conflict with what God wants?
- 3. Why was touching the lion so detrimental for Samson? How does compromising our convictions blind us to the effects of sin?
- 4. What is the motivation behind Samson's riddle to his wedding guests? What is his response when his wife gives away the answer?
- 5. How are we like Samson when we don't get our way? What is your primary emotional response to not getting what you want?
- 6. What have been some disappointments in your life that lead you to have a negative response? How does God's continued grace throughout the book of Judges allow us to trust Him with everything in our life?
