Text James 4:11-12

From the Message

We live in a world that's so broken it needs Jesus' salvation. Yet the same world is filled with enough of Jesus' grace that real transformation happens to people we might least expect. In fact, we trust that Jesus alone is the right judge of sin, sinners, and saints. So as Jesus' followers we choose intentional, creative ways of relating to others who are in the wrong, doing wrong, or got-it-wrong. We love our neighbor, and our enemy, because Jesus matters most.

Opening Interaction

Have you ever been a juror for a courtroom trial? What is that like, deciding a verdict about another person's future?

Read the passage and Discuss

Read James 4:11-12 together. What words and phrases stand out to you as very important?

Read James 4:1-10 together. How does our passage today build on the previous section?

Read James 3:13-18 together. How does our passage today relate to better wisdom?

Do you struggle with judging another person? How might you relate to them through the grace of God rather than speaking judgment over them?

Talk and pray together. Ask, *how can this group pray for you today?*
