Daniel 5

Text: Daniel 5

Purpose: Even though King Nebuchadnezzer experienced God, his eventual successor, Belshazaar, refused to honor God. In an act of arrogance, Belshazaar calls for items confiscated from Jerusalem's temple to be used in profane ways in Babylon. A visible hand appears during an idol-focused feast, and writes on a wall. None can interpret but Daniel. And Daniel relays the message, that Belshezaar's ignorance would cost him his kingdom. Babylon fell to the Persians that very night that Daniel interpreted the writing.

Opening Question: What is something you are surprised has lasted (whether in your home, in society, or in the world)? Why, do you think, the thing you've named has endured?

Read and Discuss: Daniel 5

- In this passage, what details seem important? Does anything jump out at you?
- What is the author communicating to the audience?
- What does this passage teach us about God?
- 1. Is Belshazaar acting in ignorance or arrogance? Why do you think so?
- 2. How significant is Daniel's faithfulness (over the course of his exile) in Babylon?
- 3. What is the significance of the handwritten message (5:24-28) for Belshazaar? For Daniel? For Israel?
- 4. How does the message of the handwriting connect to the dream Daniel interpreted for Nebuchadnezzar in Daniel 2:31-45?
- 5. Do you think the message of God's kingdom (Jesus) is surprising, alarming or confrontational? If so, in what ways?
- 6. Describe a time when you shared the message of God's kingdom (Jesus). How was that received? How do you feel about that interaction?
- 7. What do you think matters more faithfulness or boldness? Why do you think that?
