- **6.** How can we grow in learning to direct our judgments of others toward looking and fixing the issues we have in our own life?

Read and Discuss: Matthew 7:5

- 7. Who in your life helps you to pull the log out of your own eye?
- 8. Why is it important after dealing with our issues to still help others with the struggles they face?
