Jacob Singleness

Text: Genesis 28:1-22 and Genesis 29:1-26

Purpose: Look at the unique aspects of singleness as a follower of Jesus. How did Jacob approach the season of singleness in his life and how did God use it for a redemptive purpose?

Opening Question: Do you enjoy being alone or with people?

Read and Discuss: Genesis 28:1-22 and Genesis 29:1-26

- 1. Issac sends Jacob off with a blessing, then God invites Jacob into His blessing. What kinds of blessings do you want for your kids, grandkids, friends?
- 2. This is the first time Jacob is alone and single. What does he learn? How does God use times of aloneness to speak to us?
- 3. Jacob tried to deceive Esau and he lied to Issac. What difference do you see in Jacob in this new season of his life?
- 4. If you were single what would you need people to understand or respond to you?
