Jacob Singleness

Text: Genesis 28:1-22 and Genesis 29:1-26

Purpose: Look at the unique aspects of singleness as a follower of Jesus. How did Jacob approach the season of singleness in his life and how did God use it for a redemptive purpose?

Opening Question: *Do you enjoy being alone or with people?*

Read and Discuss: Genesis 28:1-22 and Genesis 29:1-26

1. Issac sends Jacob off with a blessing, then God invites Jacob into His blessing. What kinds of blessings do you want for your kids, grandkids, friends?
2. This is the first time Jacob is alone and single. What does he learn? How does God use times of aloneness to speak to us?
3. Jacob tried to deceive Esau and he lied to Issac. What difference do you see in Jacob in this new season of his life?
4. If you were single what would you need people to understand or respond to you?
