Read and Discuss: 1 Corinthians 15:9-10

- 5. Do you tend to focus too much on your sinfulness or focus too much on God's Grace? What's the danger of focusing too much on sinfulness? What's the danger of focusing too much on God's grace?

Read and Discuss: Acts 3:21; Revelation 21:1
