Read and Discuss: Genesis 32

- 1. Gen. 32:1-21. Why is Jacob meeting with Esau? How is Jacob manipulating this situation? Why is he afraid?
- 2. What fears do we have in asking for forgiveness?
- 3. Gen. 32:22-31 Why does Jacob wrestle with God? What happens after he wrestles with God?
- 4. How does surrendering to God allow us to start forgiving others?
- 5. Is it possible to forgive someone without them offering anything in return?
- 6. Can you forgive someone but not have reconciliation?
- 7. How does Jesus' death and resurrection allow us to start forgiving others?
