What Do I Do with My Life? Work as Worship

Text: Genesis 1:31; 2:3; 2:15; 1:28, Ecclesiastes 9:10

Purpose: Our work is greater than just bringing home a paycheck or a means to an end. The Bible refers to work as our worship and, in the midst of working, God meets us to work in us.

Opening Question: *What's the best job you've ever had?*

Read and Discuss: Genesis 1:31; 2:3; 2:15; 1:28, Ecclesiastes 9:10

2. In Gen. 2:15 and 1:28, how does God invite us into work? Before the fall, what was work supposed to be like?
3. What are some ways that we are to enjoy our work? How can work be worshipful?
4. In Ecc. 9:10, why is it important to work with all your might?
5. What are some things that God has taught you through work?
